Knock Knock Children's Museum and McKinley High Join The National Innovation Through Design Thinking Program

Knock Knock Children's Museum has partnered with McKinley High School, one of eight schools across the nation partaking in the Innovation through Design Thinking (iDT) program, a product of Arizona State University's Office of Entrepreneurship and Innovation that trains teachers to embed entrepreneurial thinking in their classrooms.

This program is designed to meet the growing need for more entrepreneurial and STEM-based curricula at the high school level, and especially among underrepresented communities and was recently highlighted at McKinley High School in Baton Rouge, Louisiana during a recent presidential visit by U.S. President Barak Obama. The students are developing a mobile app for the children's museum with input and feedback from members of Knock Knock's I/T Advisory Committee.
