



### **Special Camp Procedures for protection against Covid-19 exposure for campers and camp staff.**

- All campers and staff will wear a face mask at all times, except during lunch time and possibly movie time. During those times, campers will be placed 6 feet apart.
- All campers and staff will have their temperature checked and recorded at the beginning of each day. A forehead temp of 100.4 F is considered a fever. In the event that someone arrives with a fever on the first day, that person will go home and any fees will be refunded. If someone arrives with a fever on any day other than the first day, all of the campers and staff will have to go home and camp is canceled. Refunds will be issued for any missed days. Any exposed staff member will have to work from home for 2 weeks or until receiving a negative Covid-19 test.
- All campers will receive a box with separate materials for use throughout the week. That camper is responsible for handling his/her own box of supplies. A staff person will collect them at the end of camp for sterilization.
- All campers will bring their own snacks, lunch, and water bottle. It will be kept separate and put in the same spot every day. Campers will be responsible for unpacking and repacking their own items and cleaning up after themselves. Staff members may help open things with clean hands and a fresh set of gloves for each person.
- Campers and staff members will wash their hands in between each activity, upon arrival, and before leaving.
- Sports will be no contact and team activities will be carefully managed to prevent contact of campers and materials.
- Parents will not be allowed in the building except under special circumstances, ie a health problem that needs monitoring or an emergency. Pictures will be taken and shared with everyone after the end of camp.
