## Materials Needed:

- magazine strips
- skewer
- string
- glue stick
- scissors



## History or Vocabulary:

**Upcycling** is when you reuse discarded objects or materials in such a way to create a product of higher quality or value than the original.

**Recycling** is when you convert waste into reusable material. When you **recycle** an item, it goes back into production and is transformed into a completely different item.

We will be **upcycling** magazines into beads and then making a necklace!



## Directions:

- Take a magazine strip and use your glue stick to put glue along the entire length of the strip.
- Then take your skewer stick and start rolling up the magazine strip.
- Continue rolling up the magazine strip.
- Close it tight at the end.
- Pull your magazine bead off the skewer.
- String your beads on your thread and tie a knot in the back.
- You may cut your magazine strips in different shapes to make different styles of beads!


