Materials Needed:

- Craft sticks (already glued together)
- Yarn
- Scissors

Learning Objective:

To work hand muscles and hone fine motor skills

History or Vocabulary:

You will be making a magical yarn square by weaving yarn around the craft sticks. Weaving means you are forming a pattern by interlacing textiles. A textile is a fabric or something that can be made into a fabric.

As you weave your yarn, you'll notice it takes the shape of a square. A square has four right angles. A right angle is an angle of 90 degrees as in a corner of a square or at the intersection of two perpendicular straight line.

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- Tie the string to a craft stick and flip the knot to the back.
- Wrap the string under the stick next to the knot.
- Then bring the string over the stick.
- Then bring your string under the next stick and wrap it over.
- Continue weaving your string until your design looks like this.
- Then flip it over!
